yourself up to 100 contracts and then 1000 contracts per trade? And remember we're doing far out of the money trades here! Looking to specifically turn 10 into 100 or ride that position of the change at 80 or 90. Shoot if we can even just take it from 10 to 40 that's an incredible return. But we are targeting 10 to 100 over and over.

So with 10 contracts you can turn \$100 into \$1,000.

So with 100 contracts you can turn \$1000 into \$10,000.

So with 1000 contracts you can turn \$10,000 into \$100,000 - and that's a good goal for most people to shoot for looking to do this once twice a day, netting once or twice a day which means that your net profit, whereas some other trades could lose your net means after all wins and losses you still have 2 trades worth of winning. Yes so if you net out say, 2 trades, then you make \$200,000 for the day. Yes for the day.
